- After 1990:  
For the 1<sup>st</sup> time discussion on Development and Human Rights possible in one context
- 1993: Copenhagen and Vienna
- 2000: MDG's – Declaration and the 8 goals
- 2003: UN Common Understanding on the HRBA

## 2) Pilot Projects

- 1<sup>st</sup> Goal: Poverty Reduction
- Project:

- Initiated by German BMZ
- Start 2004
- Within UNDP: Cross Practice Project
